ELIGIBILITY

- 1. Vendors must be a restaurant, food cart, or caterer.
- 2. Vendors' business must be within the Northeast Wisconsin.
- 3. Vendors' products must be reflective of their standards (day to day).

A vendor may be deemed ineligible if

- 1. Vendor does not meet requirements listed above
- 2. Vendor is serving the same style of cuisine as several other event vendors (i.e. if five other vendors serve pizza, a sixth may not be deemed beneficial for the event).
- 3. Vendor has repeated violations from previous On Broadway Inc. events.

On Broadway Inc. retains the sole right to determine eligibility and participation of vendors.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Special 2017 Info
 - There will be themed villages created for this year's event. You will be able to have your restaurant present in one themed village –
 Italian, Mexican, Tailgate, Freshly Caught/Seafood, American Fusion, Asian or Finishing Touch (desserts). *OBI reserves the right to
 add or remove themes based on demands.
 - OBI staff will work with all restaurants to identify which village will work best for your restaurant.
- Booths
 - Vendors receive a 10ft x 10ft space with canopy, (3) 20-amp power drops, (2) 8 foot tables, (4) tent weights
 - o Power is very limited. Power will be supplied ONLY to the appliances specified in advance. If you do not specify electricity needs beforehand, your appliances may not be powered for the event.
- Menu Items
 - Menu items must be 2oz portion or less. Other guides for portion control: ¼ cup, 2-3 bites or a golf ball size. The goal of the Event is to allow people to have the opportunity to sample from as many restaurants as possible. "Taste"-sized portions means more variety for event-goers. Proper portions will help your restaurant use less product and meet the requirement to serve until 9:00 p.m. Please make sure your staff understands this.
 - Vendors are prohibited from selling beverages unless given direct permission from On Broadway Inc.



- Menu items must be priced at 5 tokens or less.
- Vendors are limited to 3 menu items.

Vendor Fees

o For the 2017 Taste event there will be a \$30 booth fee

Tokens

- Attendees exchange pre-purchased tokens for food items. It is the Restaurant's responsibility to get their tokens to OBI before 11:00 p.m. on August 3rd. OBI will reimburse 50% of tokens counted (1 token = \$1) by August 25. The other 50% covers the costs of the event and raises funds for OBI.
- All tokens will be collected in a bin provided by On Broadway Inc.
- o Immediately after the event, your bin must be taken to the Taste Restaurant Check In/Check Out.
- A representative for the restaurant will sign a release form for the tokens the night of the event. This form will give the opportunity for businesses to set up a time to be present when tokens are counted with OBI staff during between August 7-10.

Staffing

 Restaurants are responsible for staffing their own booths. OBI suggests asking family and friends to work in the booths to lower or eliminate labor costs. Reminder: Restaurants must serve food until 9:00 p.m. Have a re-supply plan in place to bring in more food as needed.

- Setup

Restaurants can set-up any time after 2:00 p.m. on August 3. Booths must be set up by 4:30 p.m. to allow enough time for the health department to perform their inspection. If more time is needed for set up, please let OBI know to make arrangements. Please check in with event staff upon arrival.

- Booth decorations & awards

- On Broadway encourages all restaurants to participate in the Best Booth Décor contest. Using your restaurants theme or a chosen theme, decorate your booth with props, costumes, etc. Tasteful decorations reflect the character and ambience of individual restaurants and boost the visibility and first impression of your restaurant. Also encouraged is additional signage, business card bowls, games/activities, menus, etc. that represent the spirit of the Restaurant.
- Awards will be given for the <u>Best Booth Décor</u> (all booths), <u>Best Taste</u> (per village), as well as <u>Best Presentation</u> (per village).
 Awards will be announced on the main stage the evening of the event. Make 2017 memorable with an award from Taste On Broadway for your restaurant!

- Rain plan

If weather outlooks predict significant rain or storms on Thursday during the event, Taste will be moved to the rain location. OBI will
contact participants the week of, if the event has been moved, including new site layout and other details. If you do not hear from
OBI by Wednesday, August 2 the event WILL BE OUTSIDE on Broadway.

- Break down / clean up

- The public expects food served until 9:00 p.m. Therefore, break down cannot begin until after 9:00 p.m., and must be completed by 11:00 p.m. No vehicular movement is permitted within the event boundaries until after 11:00 p.m. The street remains closed to thrutraffic until 12:00 a.m.
- o Restaurants must bring tokens to Event Staff by 11:00 p.m. on August 3, 2017. Leftover supplies that were provided by OBI should be brought to the check out station. Please do not take these with you.
- Restaurants are not allowed to dump grease or any other debris on the street or into the curbside storm water drain at anytime. On Broadway will provide a "grey water" dump station.

Supplies

On Broadway will supply you with napkins, plates, bowls, spoons and forks for customers.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- 1. Any vendor is welcome to apply for a booth in the 2017 Auto Select Taste On Broadway.
- 2. Applications must be received by June 14, 2017 at 4:00pm.
- 3. Vendor must submit with the application:
 - a. \$30 booth fee
 - b. Menu items and token values
 - c. Mobile Food Permit from Brown County Health Department
- 4. All applicants will be notified of selection status the week of June 19.
